*TIP: Be efficient! Talking to advisors at the 4-year school before you begin your first college experience gives you a head-start on knowing what will help you graduate on time from the 4-year school.*

*TIP: UNT MUSIC DEGREES REQUIRE proficiencies in theory and applied lessons, as well as degree-specific applied lessons and music ensembles at UNT. For efficient graduation planning, prospective UNT music majors should apply, audition and transfer to UNT as early as possible in their college career.*

MUSIC MAJOR OR MINOR: planning courses that will meet BOTH schools' requirements simultaneously.**

### TRANSFER UNIVERSITY CORE CURRICULUM

1. English Composition I and II (Technical Writing is not accepted for Music degrees)
2. Math: one math course (Algebra is not accepted)
3. Lab Science: two courses (one selection should be a Physics course in Musical Acoustics)
4. Visual and Performing Arts: one course from Introductory Music History, Survey of Music Literature

### TRANSFER MUSIC MAJOR COURSES - take music courses that will apply to the Music degree at UNT

Note: UNT major-specific minimum grades may be required.

1. Music Theory (Harmony) -- up to four semesters (grades of "C" or better)
2. Aural Skills (alternate titles: Ear Training, Sight Singing, or Solfege) – up to four semesters, "C" or better.
3. One course: Intro Music History or Music Lit Survey (will also satisfy Visual and Performing Arts Core)
4. Large Performance Groups (Choir, Band, Orchestra) – up to four semesters. Note: BM major-specific ensembles required.
5. Non-Piano majors for Music degrees: Piano class or applied piano lessons – up to two credits (placement and/or continuation in Keyboard at UNT is required until proficient ([www.music.unt.edu/piano](http://www.music.unt.edu/piano))).

### TRANSFER ADVANCED LEVEL COURSES from 4 yr schools that will apply to Music degrees at UNT:

1. Music History, two courses (Early Music – 1750 and Music History from 1750 – Present)
2. Conducting, one course
3. Up to three semesters of Chamber Music (Performance Majors)

### UNT MUSIC MINOR: TRANSFER COURSES THAT WILL APPLY

1. Music Theory and Aural Skills – two semesters of each, "C" or better (Music Theory Fundamentals does not apply)
2. Lessons, one or more instruments/voice – four semester hours of credit
3. Music History – two courses, 6 advanced music hours (advanced available only at 4-yr programs)
