MAKE TRANSFER COURSES WORK FOR YOU!

Be efficient! **Talk to advisors at the 4-year school** *before* you begin your college career. Get information early to know what courses will help you graduate on time.

Take Core and Music courses that will apply directly to UNT College of Music four-year degrees. For timely degree completion, prospective music majors should audition and transfer as early as possible in their college career.

UNIVERSITY CORE CURRICULUM

Select courses from the approved course list at your school or at UNT for each Core category. UNT Music degrees require the following courses, which also meet Core requirements:

1. English Composition I and II (Technical Writing is not recommended for BM degrees)
2. Math: one math course, College Algebra or a higher math
3. Two Lab Science courses: one selection should be a Physics course in Musical Acoustics
4. Visual and Performing Arts: Introductory Music History, Survey of Music Literature or Music Appreciation

MUSIC MAJOR COURSES that satisfy Music degree requirements at UNT:

1. Music Theory (Harmony) -- up to four semesters (grades of "C" or better) (Music Theory Fundamentals does not apply)
2. Aural Skills (alternate titles may be Ear Training, Sight Singing, or Solfege) – up to four semesters, "C" or better
3. One course: Intro Music History or Music Lit Survey (will also satisfy Visual and Performing Arts Core)
4. Large Performance Ensembles (Choir, Band, Orchestra) – up to four credits. Note: BM major-specific ensembles may be required.

5. Non-Piano majors in Music: Piano class or applied piano lessons – up to two credits (placement and/or continuation in keyboard at UNT is required until proficient (www.music.unt.edu/piano)).

ADVANCED LEVEL COURSES TRANSFERRED FROM FOUR-YEAR SCHOOLS:

1. Music History (Early Music – 1750 and Music History from 1750 – Present)
2. Conducting
3. Up to three semesters of Chamber Music (Performance Majors)

MUSIC MINOR

1. Music Theory and Aural Skills – two semesters of each, “C” or better (Music Theory Fundamentals does not apply)
2. Lessons, one or more instruments/voice – four semester hours of credit
3. Music History – 6 advanced hours
