Honor Choir Camp Scholarship Program

Description: The MS/JH Honor Choir Camp Scholarship Program is tied to the Outstanding Chorister Awards. The purpose of the scholarship is to augment the chorister award with a \$75.00 scholarship that encourages deserving and motivated students to attend the 4-day MS/JH Honor Choir Camp at the Cambiata Institute of America for Early Adolescent Vocal Music at the University of North Texas in Denton, 30 miles north of Dallas.

Limitations: The scholarship is available to the first 50 scholarship winners to register for the MS/JR Honor Choir Camp.

Costs: Day Camper w/Scholarship, \$125.00; Day Camper w/o Scholarship, \$200.00; Boarding Camper w/Scholarship \$200.00; Boarding Camper w/o Scholarship, \$275.00.
