Large ensemble auditions: Wind Symphony, Symphonic Band, Concert Band, and Brass Band and classical percussion ensemble auditions – Round one – Monday, August 23rd.

- Beginning August 2nd **email** the Wind Studies office at diann.overgaard@unt.edu to make an appointment for a round one audition time with your studio faculty. In your email, include your name, instrument and phone number. Appointments will be made on a first-come, first-served basis. Do not call or come to the Wind Studies office for an appointment.
 - These auditions will take place in the Main Music Building on Ave C in room 142. If you are in Marching Band, they will allow for you to leave practice for this audition as long as you give your section leader advance notice.
 - **Requirements:** Snare Etude #9 from *Advanced Studies in Snare Drum* by Mitchell Peters. This etude is on the wind studies website to download - www.music.unt.edu/windstudies. You will also perform a short etude or solo on another percussion instrument of your choice, such as timpani or keyboards. Sight-reading is also required.
 - This is a two round process. After round one is complete, assigned times for round two will be posted on the Wind Studies bulletin board near MU258 and on the Wind Studies office door (brick bldg. next to the Murchison Performing Arts Center).
