Students wishing to pursue a related field outside the College of Music must submit this form to the Graduate Studies Office along with a justification of ca. 300 words explaining how the proposed related field will further their professional, artist and academic goals. The form needs to include the course numbers and catalogue descriptions of each proposed course. The student needs to find a related field professor to serve on the Doctoral Advisory Committee (if applicable) and administer the written and oral portions of the qualifying exam. The Graduate Performance Degree Committee must approve the related field *before* the student files the Degree Plan and Committee Designation Form.
