## Degree requirements

### Hours required and general/college requirements

### Other requirements

- All non-keyboard majors must enroll in Keyboard Skills classes each long term/semester until Secondary Piano Proficiency is passed.
- Keyboard majors must pass Open Score/Transposition Exam.
- Candidates must pass the Concentration Proficiency Exam.
- Keyboard and Guitar concentration students must take secondary voice/instrument appropriate to the intended teaching area and qualify for participation in the appropriate music laboratory (see section on "Graduation Requirements" in catalog).
