*May also include Secondary Lessons (MUAS 15##) taken for one credit hour per semester. All non-keyboard majors must enroll in secondary piano each long semester until Piano Proficiency is passed. If more than 2 hours of class piano are needed the other hours will subtract from free electives and may increase total degree hours. Violin, viola, cello and double bass majors also take two additional hours of secondary string.

Students may select one course from MUMH 1610, 2050, 2060, 3100, or 3200 to satisfy the Music Communication or Literature requirement ***Two courses from any 3000- or 4000-level MUET or MUTH course not already taken for degree, any 4000-level MUAG or MUMH literature course, MUAE 3100, MUCE 4000, MUAG 3500, MUCP 3090, 3320, 3670, 4695, MUJS 3070. Woodwinds majors must take MUTH 3420 as one of their options. For core class options please refer to catalog.unt.edu under "University Core Curriculum" or access your degree audit through www.MyDegreeAudit.unt.edu ¹Enrollment in a large ensemble (MULB) is required each long term.

Note: MUAG 4360 and MUAG 4370 (Instrumental Pedagogy/Repertoire) course offerings vary by instrument. It may be offered in Fall, Spring or Summer only. Woodwinds is offered in the Summer only. Brass students must take this course in the Spring semester of their Junior year.
