² May also include Secondary Lessons (MUAS 15##) taken for one credit hour per semester. All non-keyboard majors must enroll in secondary piano each long semester until Piano Proficiency is passed. If more than 2 hours of class piano are needed the other hours will subtract from free electives and may increase total degree hours.

³ MUCP electives to be chosen from: MUCP 4320, 4590, 4685, 4690, 4695, or MUCP 4590/MUEN 4595 taken in combination.
