## about our guest artist

New York City-based soprano Hannah Madeleine Goodman is an emerging artist on the operatic stage, hailed for her "very adept coloratura" (Parterre), her "exquisite dynamics" (Voce di Meche), and reviewed as "outstanding," "with a radiant smile ... [she] delivered the aria beautifully" (CityWatchLA). After making her soloist debut in recital for LA Opera in 2018, Ms. Goodman enjoyed making her NYC debut as Constance (The Sorcerer) with Utopia Opera in early 2019. Operatic highlights include: Susanna (Le nozze di Figaro) with Hawaii Performing Arts Festival and the Center for Jewish History; Amadeus Live with LA Opera; Emmie (Albert Herring) with Utopia Opera; Pamina cover (Die Zauberflöte) with Opera On Tap; LA Opera and Opera Saratoga outreach tours. Ms. Goodman was a Young Artist at the 2019 iSING! International Festival in China and a Resident Artist at Opera Saratoga in 2017. Goodman sings everything, from classics of the Great American Songbook repertoire to contemporary belter anthems. Drawing upon both her operatic and musical theatre experience, Ms. Goodman uniquely combines her years of piano training, love of writing, and natural affinity for comedy (including training at The Second City Hollywood) on the cabaret stage. Ms. Goodman has written and premiered two original shows at Upstairs at Vitello's (formerly the E Spot Lounge) in Los Angeles: Too Fat For Musical Theater, Too Skinny for Opera (2017) and Almost Like Being in Love (2018). Ms. Goodman made a costar appearance on the television series "Glee." She is an alumni of LA's Next Great Stage Star Competition, where BroadwayWorld praised her performance as "beautiful ... [one] of the highlights." Ms. Goodman is a Teaching Artist for the Metropolitan Opera Guild since 2018, a USC Thornton School of Music alumna, and a proud member of AGMA, Actors' Equity, and SAG-AFTRA.
